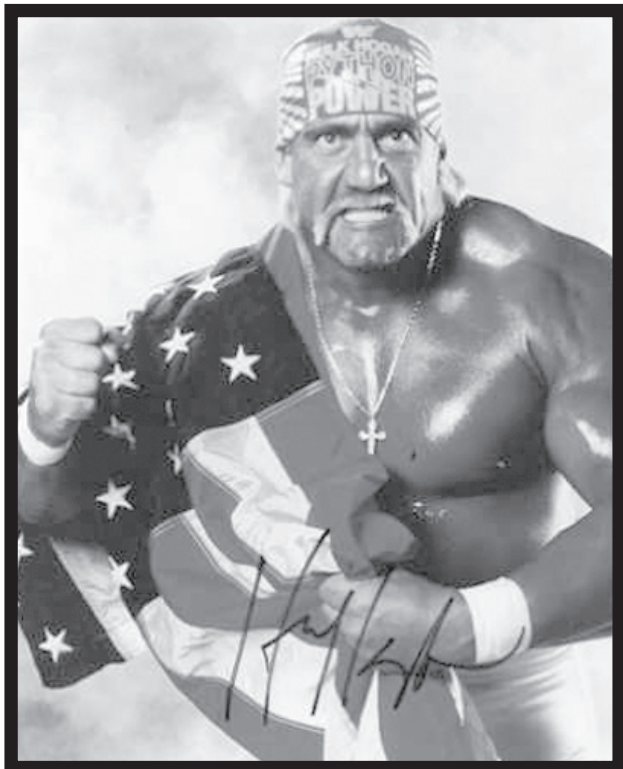
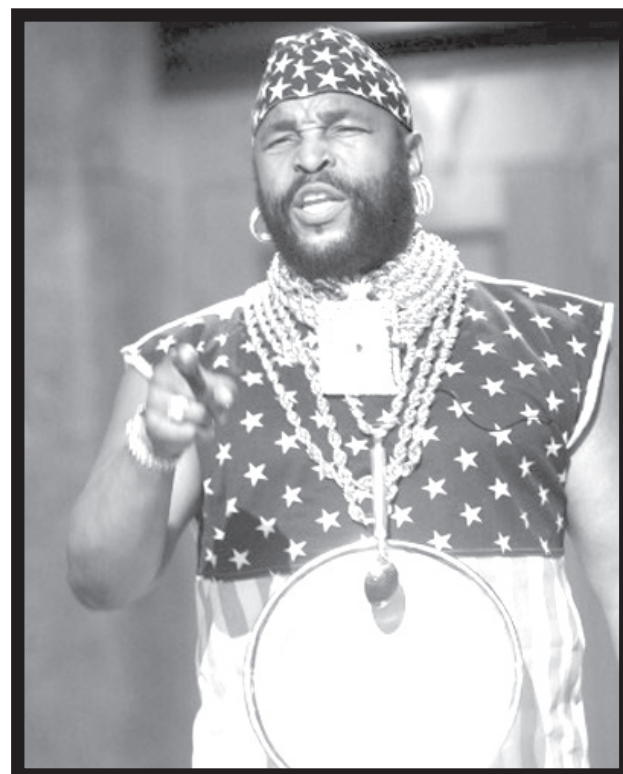


The LowDown Person of the year

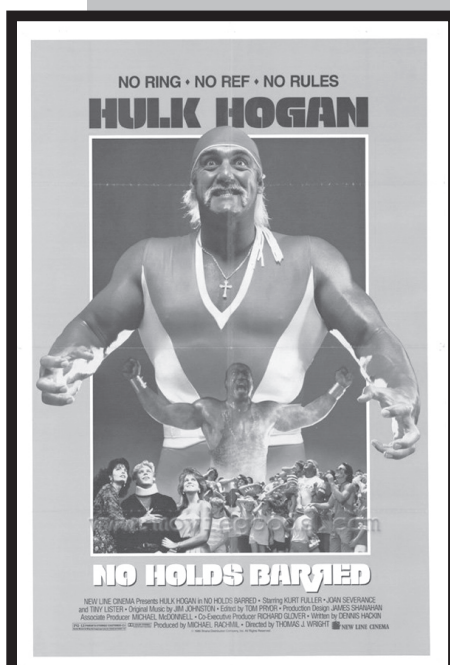
